

Protocol to get access to the CIAN SAN over Ethernet Network

MAC Users

- 1- Contact CIAN to get a username and a password
- 2- In Finder, press Command + K
- 3- Server address: engin.biol.mcgill.ca
- 4- Type your username
- 5- Type your password
- 6- Press Enter
- 7- Select CIANsan volume to mount
- 8- Click OK
- 9- You are now connected to the CIAN SAN! You can work on it as if it was an additional hard drive.

PC Users

- 1- Contact CIAN to get a username and a password
- 2- In Start menu, click <Run>
- 3- Server address: \\132.206.213.193
- 4- Type your username
- 5- Type your password
- 6- Press Enter
- 7- Select CIANsan volume to mount
- 8- You are now connected to the CIAN SAN! You can work on it as if it was an additional hard drive.
- 9- When you are done log off the computer to avoid other users to access your account/folder in CIANsan

Note to PC users: Depending on your computer networking capability, you may have to use third-party software such as WinSCP (freely available at <http://winscp.net/>) to connect to the server.
